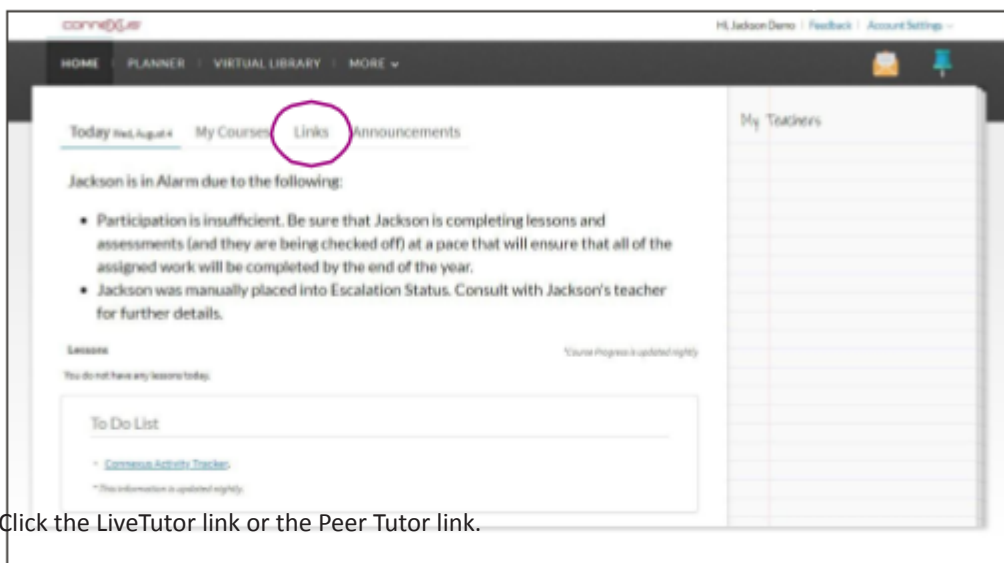

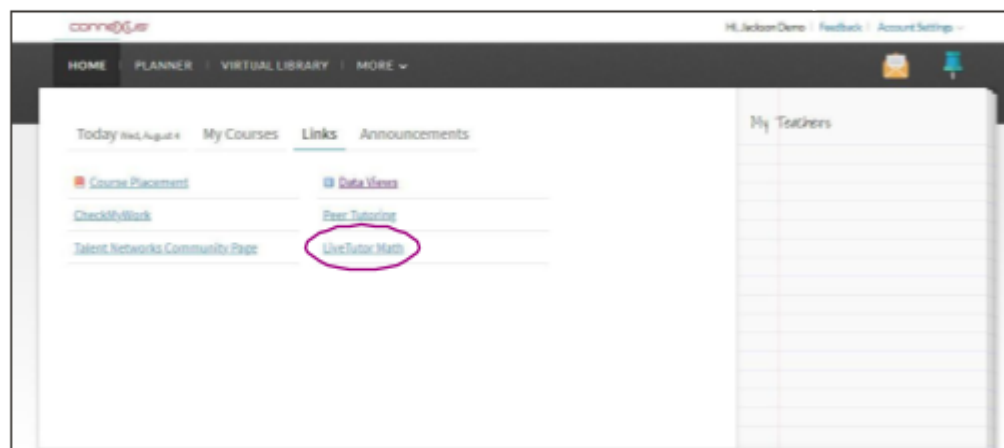
Accessing LiveTutor and Peer Tutor

1. From your student home page, click the “Links” tab.

3. You will then enter a LiveLesson waiting room. When you enter the LiveLesson waiting room, locate the text box and type your:

- Course
- Unit/Lesson
- Page Number
- Problem Number
